

# Sustainability Lecture Series



## What is needed to transform agriculture and food systems in the face of climate change?

Sustainability Science Centre presents a sustainability lecture on 22 September 2017, with Bruce Campbell, Director of the CGIAR Research Programme on Climate Change, Agriculture and Food Security (CCAFS) and a staff member of the International Centre for Tropical Agriculture (CIAT).

**This lecture will address how something is wrong with the global food system when nearly one billion people go hungry and more than one billion over-consume; and how agriculture is the major driver of global environmental change.**

**Dr Bruce Campbell** has degrees in Ecology from Cape Town, Minnesota and Utrecht, but has increasingly moved into inter-disciplinary work, championing new approaches to doing applied research on natural resource management. He operates out of the CCAFS office at the University of Copenhagen in Denmark.

**Katherine Richardson**, Professor and Leader of Sustainability Science Centre, will moderate the talk.
